The agenda of the meeting:

20th September 2022/Tuesday

Partners arrived in Manavgat and settled at their hotel.

21st September 2022/Wednesday

Partners arrived at the host school and attended the official welcome ceremony. Then there were ice-breaker games for students and a short tour at school which ended at the wish tree where partners made their wishes in Anatolian style. After the coffee break partner schools made presentations about their schools and countries and the host school made a presentation on basic Turkish traditions.

After the project activities at school partners visited the Manavgat waterfall and had a trip to Side where they were able to see the Side Museum, the Ancient Theatre, the Harbour, the Old Town of Side and the Temple of Apollo.

22nd September 2022/Thursday

Partners went on a Daily trip to Antalya. The day started with a field trip to the largest banana plantation facility called "Aymuz" where partners had a guided tour and were able to learn about organic and sustainable farming and growing fruits such as bananas, avocodos, and etc.. One student from each partner was allowed to see the laboratories as well.

Then partners visited Aspendos Ancient Theatre which is one of the most well-preserved ones in the country.

After the lunch partners drove to Antalya and explored Antalya Old Town and had some free time. On the way back to Manavgat it was time to see the amazing Karpuzkaldıran Waterfall which is a must-see natural beauty of Antalya.

23rd September 2022/Friday

Partners gathered at school in the morning and they attended a seminar on "Ecology and Biodiversity" given by two academicians from Akdeniz University. Then partners went to the school garden where they planted seeds and created Erasmus+ Memory Garden. In the garden there was a mini workshop on creating seed balls. Partners also had the opportunity to have a mini session on "healing natural beauties of the nature" and tasted a traditional Turkish hot drink called "sahlep" as well as some herbal teas.

After the coffee break students had workshops on digital tools in international teams and also evaluated the project meeting online.

In the afternoon there was the cultural exchange session and partners performed some national dances to each other. After the bracelet making workshop led by one of the Turkish teachers, there was the closing ceremony and the certification.


