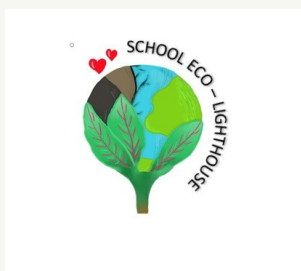

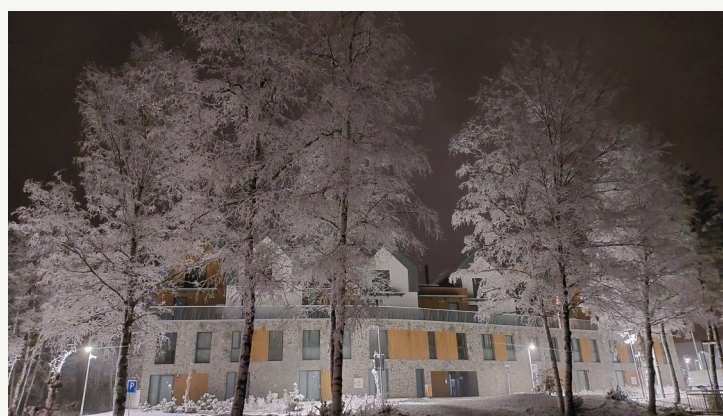

The second meeting for students took place in Kezmarok, Slovakia between 16 and 18 January 2023. All partner schools were present at the meeting with students accompanied by teachers held by the Slovakian partner school, Zakladna skola s materskou skolou sv. Kriza Kezmarok, located in Kezmarok/ Slovakia.

The agenda of the meeting:

15th January 2023/Sunday

Partners arrived in Kezmarok and settled at their hotel.

16th January 2023/Monday

Partners attended the official welcome ceremony at the hotel they stayed and they introduced their schools and their regions to each other. After lunch partner schools departed for Liptovský Mikuláš and visited the Slovak Museum of Nature Conservation and Caving where students participated in workshops and afterwards visited the museum.

17th January 2023/Tuesday

Partners went on a daily trip to Slovakian High Tatras where they observed and learned about high mountain ecosystem and tourism. Partners also had a nice walk up to the ice house and visited the ice church. Then via cable car partners returned back to Skalnaté Pleso and had free time in the late afternoon.

18th January 2023/Wednesday

After breakfast partners traveled to Základná škola s materskou školou Kezmarok and students attended analysis of mineral water in mixed teams. After lunch at school partners had a walk in the centre of Kezmarok and visited the historical Lyceum where they had a guided tour. Then they had a tour in the city and visited the historical buildings and monuments of the royal city such as Basilica of St. Cross and Kezmarok Castle. After the practical presentations of regional customs there was the closing ceremony and the certification.

19th January 2023/Thursday

The meeting finished and partners left Kezmarok for their countries.



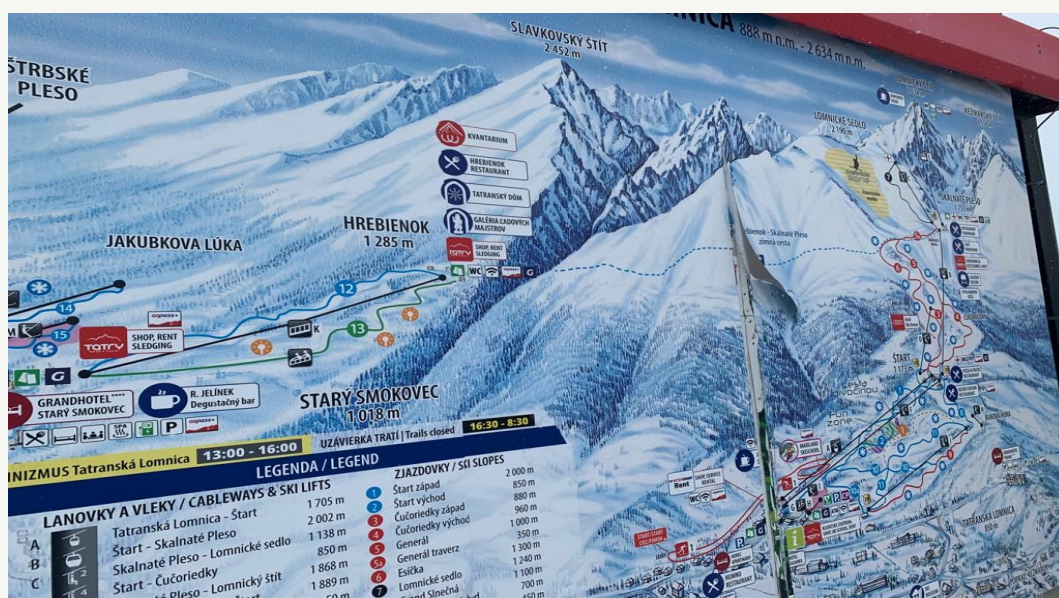
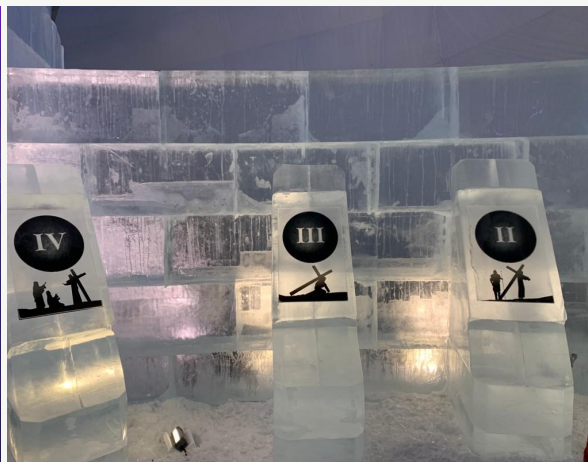
